
CONTEXT



- UK Tier-2 National HPC
- Funded in 2019 by the Engineering and Physical Sciences Research Council (EPSRC), jointly managed by Queen's University Belfast and Ulster University.
- Hosts the Kelvin-2 HPC system (first and only Tier 2 in NI)
- Team 2-11
- Communications/engagement managed by team on an ad-hoc basis


